COME HOLY SPIRIT, Come by means of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, your dearly beloved spouse.

COME HOLY SPIRIT, Unite and heal all the families of the world.

COME HOLY SPIRIT, and pour out your Holy Spirit upon all the children of the world.

As children and young people are gathered throughout the world before the Most Blessed Sacrament we will light this candle as a sign of our united prayer and also *place our petitions before this image of our Blessed Mother's Immaculate Heart!*

Crowning Prayer

"Heavenly Father, to You we offer praise and thanksgiving, because what You have kept hidden from the proud and learned, You have revealed to us the merest of children.

Thank you Father, for You have graciously willed it so. We thank you for sending our Blessed Mother to Fatima, Portugal where she entrusted a message of hope for the whole world to three children and told them that "God wishes to establish devotion to my Immaculate Heart in the world."

Immaculate Heart of Mary, the children of the world want to help you bring the world back to God. So we will begin to make frequent Visits to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, pray the rosary and make sacrifices to change the hearts of many.

So today, as a sign of our promise, we will crown this beautiful image of your Immaculate Heart before the entire world."
