

The following are three different levels of participation for your students and children:
Ideally, each level will involve praying before our Eucharistic Lord exposed in Exposition.
However, if this is not possible, then it is of great benefit to pray in His Presence in Reposition, with Him in the tabernacle.

First Level, for teachers or parents

In school or at home - show the EWTN promotional video of Archbishop Aymond's invitation to the children of the world.
Gather the children into their parish church or chapel.
Light a Candle of Unity to include further explanation of the Worldwide Children's Eucharistic Holy Hour
Spend some silent time of reflection before the Most Blessed Sacrament and recite some prayers that are familiar to them, such as the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.
Stress that Jesus shows us His love by choosing to spend time with us in His Eucharist, and we show our love for Him by spending time with Him in Adoration.

Second Level, for teachers or parents

Show the EWTN promotional video of Archbishop Aymond's invitation to the children of the world.

- Light a Candle of Unity to include further explanation of the Worldwide Children's Eucharistic Holy Hour

Include the four devotions for spiritual unity found here (link)

- Children before the Most Blessed Sacrament
- Pray the Prayers of Eucharistic Reparation that the Angel of Peace taught the Little Shepherds of Fatima, to console the Heart of Jesus for the indifference He suffers in the Most Blessed Sacrament.
- Pray the Entrustment Prayer to the Immaculate Heart of Mary
- Pray the World Mission Rosary for the families of the world

Third Level, for teachers or parents and clergy

The third level involves additional devotion and pageantry that the children may really appreciate and remember.

This can involve a Procession of a statue of our Blessed Mother while the children wave handkerchiefs, crowning, student presentations, Exposition, Adoration, and Solemn Benediction.

- o Pray the Rosary for the families of the world**
